Saint Louis University School of Law (SLU LAW) is pleased to announce the 2018 *LL.M. in American Law for Foreign Lawyers* scholarships for law students and legal professionals from traditionally disadvantaged and marginalized groups (such as LGBTI, persons with disabilities, refugees, asylees in the US, indigenous people and national and religious minorities).

SLU LAW will award one full-tuition scholarship and three 30% reduced tuition scholarships to extraordinary LL.M. applicants who meet the SLU LAW admission requirements and who successfully explain, in a 500 word essay, how their identity affected their lives and future plans. Students who wish to be considered for this scholarship should submit their application by May 5, 2018.
